

# Summer Camp Suggested Packing List

This list is provided as a simple guideline to plan what you will need for your week at camp. We recommend you pack your items in either a foot locker or suitcase that can be locked. Clothing and personal property should be permanently marked with name and troop number for easy identification and lost and found.

Medications need to be in original container and placed in a plastic bag with participants name, parent's name, troop number. A note should be placed in the bag with instructions, dosage.

Snacks are permitted but is the responsibility of the youth to keep in footlocker and not to attract any wildlife. Should be easily sealed.

## **Official BSA Uniform:**

- 1-2 BSA Class A Shirts (flags, meals, campfires)
- 1-2 BSA pants (shorts /long/zip off)
- 2-3 pair scout socks (to wear with uniform)
- Troop neckerchief
- OA sash for OA members

## **Daily Clothing Items:**

- 6 pair of socks (can be scout socks if you want)
- 6 class B t-shirts (scout appropriate)
- 6 pair underwear
- 3-5 pair activity shorts (can be scout if you want)
- Sweatshirt / Jacket
- Sleepwear
- Hiking shoes/boots
- Extra pair of shoes/moccasins (no open-toe sandals or shoes)
- Raingear / Poncho
- Bathing Suit
- Swim towel
- Hat
- Belt

## **Toiletries:**

- Soap
- 1-2 Bath towel / washcloths
- Toothbrush & Tooth paste
- Comb or Brush
- Non-aerosol deodorant
- Shampoo / conditioner
- Shaving cream / Razor (if needed)
- Tissues
- Non-aerosol Febreze to spray on uniform
- Shower clogs/sandals (only to be worn in shower)
- Feminine products

## **Bedding:**

- Sleeping pad in case we are in tents and you want something on the cot
- Sleeping bag (nights can get cool) or blankets
- Sheets
- Pillow with pillow case

## **Camp gear:**

- Footlocker: 13-14" tall / suitcase - with lock (combo lock best -provide code to SM or second key provide to SM)
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Water bottle / camel pack (don't pack in footlocker. Will need on Sunday when we arrive)
- Dirty Laundry Bag
- Hanger(s) to hang up uniform
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Day Pack

## **Other Items:**

- Non-aerosol Insect Repellant
- Sunscreen
- Medications as noted above
- Boy Scout Book / MB books
- Watch (can't be cell phone, see note)
- Pocket Knife (if you don't have totem chip yet you will need to provide to SM until you complete at camp)
- Notebook and writing utensils
- Spending Money (souvenirs, snacks)
- Fishing gear
- Light duty cloth line

## **Optional Items:**

- Compass
- Bible or Prayer book
- Small folding chair
- Sunglasses
- Board/card games
- Camera (other than cell phone)
- Music instrument
- Swim goggles

## **Not permitted:**

- Cell Phones / Electronic Games
- Axes, saws, sheath knives/fixed blade knives, fireworks, weapons
- Pets
